# How to Record Your Project Video in FlipGrid

Follow these steps to record your Google Slides presentation with a small video of you talking

STEP 1: GO TO https://flipgrid.com/6d5de790

**STEP 2: LOG IN** using your STEM Wizard username

## STEP 3: RECORD YOUR PRESENTATION

- 1) Open your Google Slides presentation in a separate browser tab
- 2) Go back to the FlipGrid tab and click the Add a Response button
- 3) Click Options
- 4) Click **Record Screen**
- 5) Click the **Start Screen Recording** button
- 6) Select **Your Entire Screen** and click on the picture of your screen
- 7) Click Share to start the recording
- 8) Switch back to your Google Slides browser tab and click the *Present* button
- 9) Give your presentation. Press the space bar to move to the next slide
- 10) When done, hover your mouse over the small video of you and click **Back to Tab** to go back to FlipGrid and click **Stop Recording** (or press the ESC key to return to FlipGrid)
- 11) (OPTIONAL STEP) If you want to trim your recording, do this:
  - a. click on the rectangle timeline underneath your recording
  - b. slide the blue bar on the left to where you want your recording to start
  - c. slide the blue bar on the right to where you want your recording to end
  - d. Click "Confirm"
- 12) Click the Next button

## **STEP 4: ENTER INFO** On the *Post To Topic* Screen:

- 1) Type your Project Title in the Caption Box.
- 2) Check that the Display Name shows your project number. (You can find your Project Number in STEM Wizard: click on your name in the upper right corner then click on "Profile".)

### **STEP 5: POST VIDEO**

Click the blue **Post to Topic** button. Be patient -- it may take a few minutes to upload. Wait until you see the "Your video is posted" message before leaving the web page.
